

A green fish, a shark, a shell ... BINGO!

Bingo is a fun and simple game for beginners. When playing simple board games children learn to take turns and play by a set of rules. They practice language and numeracy skills as well as working on tricky, co-operative social skills.

Remember, young children are just starting to understand the concept of rules, turn taking and winning and losing, so playing with an adult who can encourage and support them while they learn is a great idea.

making Sea Bingo

Print out the four player boards. Each features a different combination of ten sea creatures.

Print out the page of sea creature cards, and cut them up into individual cards.

Laminate the boards and cards (or cover with clear self adhesive book covering) to help them last a little longer.

Tip: The game prints nicely onto lightweight card or cover paper. They also print well onto good quality bright white paper but there may be some colour show through on regular printer paper.

what you need to play

4 printed play boards

20 different sea creature cards

A collection of counters, shells or other objects (10 per player)



how to play


For 2-4 players

Each player chooses a playing board and collects ten counters or shells.

Lay the sea creature cards face down on the table.


Take it in turns to turn over a card. Each player who has the sea creature shown on the upturned card on their playing board covers it with a counter or shell.

Keep turning over cards and covering sea creatures until someone has all of their creatures covered and shouts "Bingo!"










