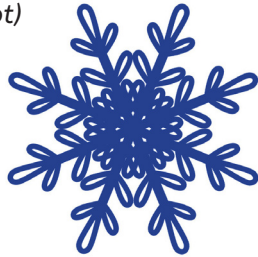


WINTER SONG CARDS

(sung to the tune of Frère Jacques)

(sung to the tune of Teddy Bear, Teddy Bear, Turn Around)

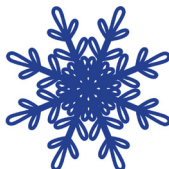
Snowflakes, snowflakes, spin around,

Walk around.
(pretend to walk like a polar bear on hands and legs)

Growl out loud.
(make a growling sound)



I'm a Little Penguin

(sung to the tune of I'm a Little Tea Pot)

I'm a little penguin,
black and white,
(hold arms straight at each side, hands and fingers outstretched to the side)
I can waddle left
(waddle a few steps to the left)
And waddle right.
(waddle a few steps to the right)
When I am in danger
or get a fright,
I quickly swim,
(move arms up and down like flippers)
Right out of sight.



I'm a Little Snowman

(sung to the tune of I'm a Little Tea Pot)

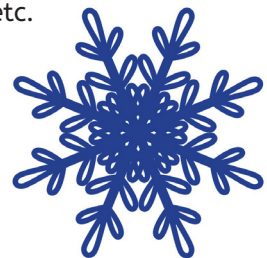
I'm a little snowman,

(hold rounded arms in the front of your body)

(wag pointer finger up and down)

Additional verses:

Put on our coat *(pretend to put on a coat)*
Put on our gloves *(pretend to put on gloves)*
Put on our scarf *(pretend to put on a scarf)*
Put on our boots *(pretend to put on boots)*
Play in the snow (or rain) *(pretend to be playing in the snow (or rain))*

Incy Wincy Spider

The incy wincy spider,
(touch right pinky to left thumb and right thumb to left pinky)
Climbed up the water spout,
(separate bottom thumb and pinky and twist hands up so the fingers meet again at the top)
Down came the rain,
(wiggle fingers and move hands downwards)
And washed the spider out.
(hold both hands with palms upwards)
Out came the sunshine,
(draw a large circle with fingers outstretched)
And dried up all the rain,
(wiggle fingers and move hands upwards)
So the itsy bitsy spider,
(repeat first action)
Climbed up the spout again.
(repeat second action)
