We suggest printing re-usable game boards and game pieces onto matte photo paper or card stock and laminating before use.

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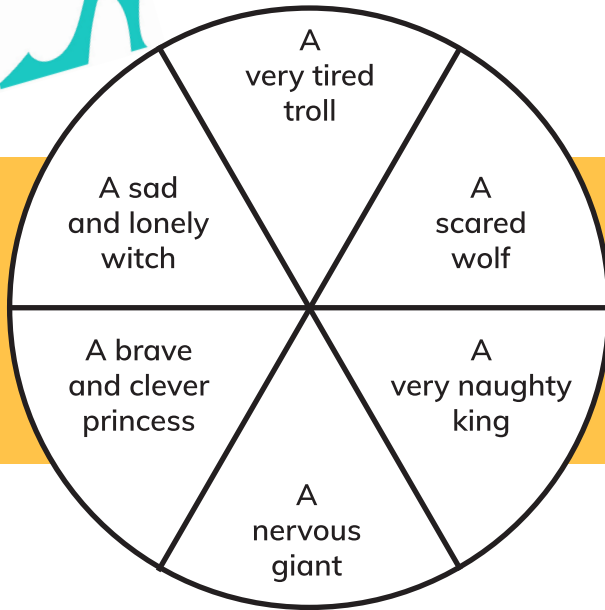
